HOW IT WORKS:



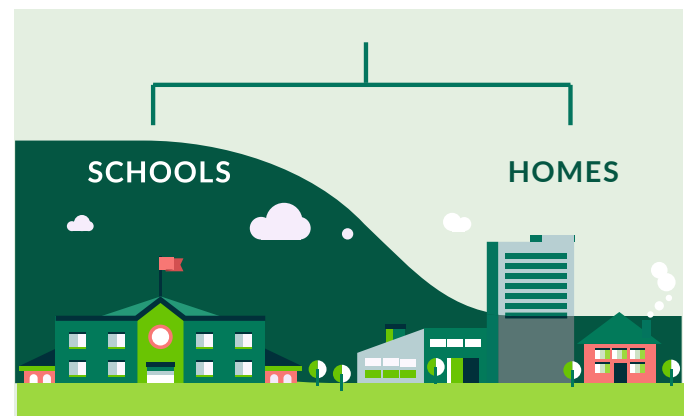
1) REQUEST: Principals request supplies/services based on teacher and student need.



2) APPROVE: Central office reviews, edits, and approves these requests in real-time.



3) PROCESS: Together, principals and central office decide whether to source requested supplies from warehouse inventory, preferred service providers, or Amazon Business.



4) DELIVER: Supplies sourced from Amazon Business are shipped to schools or directly to student or staff homes.



This free requisition tool serves as a central repository for all expenses (sourced from any vendor) related to a district's COVID-19 response. Expenses are conveniently logged to support reimbursements or grant requests for relief funding.
